STCC began identifying courses that fulfill the MassTransfer Block (MTB) on their website in fall 2014 during initial implementation of a new course numbering system that will be phased in over time. New STCC course numbers feature a three-letter course prefix.

For example: **ENGL 100 - English Composition I** was converted to **ENG 101 - English Composition I** in fall 2014.

As new course numbers are implemented, corresponding online course descriptions will identify those that fulfill MTB distribution requirements at STCC. MTB distribution requirements are denoted throughout this document as part of the STCC course title, as follows:

ENG 101/A English Composition I

This course counts toward fulfillment of the MTB Composition/Writing requirement.

STCC codes and corresponding credit requirements for completion of the 34-credit MTB are denoted as follows:

A = English Composition/Writing (6 credits/2 courses)

B = Behavioral & Social Sciences (9 credits/3 courses)

C = Humanities & Fine Arts (9 credits/3 courses)

D = Mathematics & Quantitative Reasoning (3 credits/1 course)

E = Natural & Physical Sciences* (7 credits/2 courses, including one 4-credit lab course)

*Lab components of courses are listed as separate course numbers but are completed concurrently with the lecture.

Obsolete STCC course entries (preceded by #) generally are **not** coded for MTB in this document.
